The University of the Fraser Valley invites applications for a full-time faculty member in its <u>Teacher Education Department</u> (TED) which includes undergraduate level pre-requisite courses, a post-degree Bachelor of Education (B.Ed) for prospective elementary, middle and secondary teachers and a Master of Education (M.Ed) in Educational Leadership and Mentorship. Both the B.Ed and the M.Ed programs are located on the Abbotsford campus. The mission of the TED is to educate teachers who will become responsible and effective professionals. Through our emphasis on the integration of knowledge, educational theory and practice, on social justice, and on curriculum development, our graduates will be distinguished by the knowledge, skills, and values expected of educators in the contemporary classroom. The position is subject to budgetary approval.

This is a position for an individual who enjoys the challenge of working in a small, yet innovative, department and whose philosophy about pre-service and in-service teacher education is consistent with the TED's Mission Statement and Department Values, as well as the Program Goals for both the M.Ed and the B.Ed. The successful candidate will have knowledge of the five department values and be able to embed these values into curriculum design and delivery. As well, the applicant should have the expertise and ability to teach across a variety of subject areas in the B.Ed. This experience and expertise will enable the successful applicant to advance UFV's strategic plan and Institutional Goals by supporting the implementation of strong graduate programs, the inclusion of integrated experiential learning, and the modelling of exceptional teaching practices.

The individual will be expected to teach courses in the TED (both B.Ed and M.Ed programs), mentor teacher candidates during practica, work collaboratively with a variety of faculty and seconded faculty mentors, and participate in the TED teacher candidate admissions and orientation processes. There are additional expectations involving service to the university and the local community. The successful applicant will also be expected to maintain an active research and/or scholarship agenda with a focus on teacher education, leadership education, and/or K – 12 education.

- Knowledge of the BC school system (preferably in local school districts)
- Mentoring experience (practicing teachers and/or teacher candidates)
- Active research interest in teacher education, educational leadership, and/or K-12 education with proven knowledge of a variety of research traditions.

- Experience mentoring and supervising graduate students.
- Evidence of experience and/or scholarship oriented toward a progressive vision of public education that is inclusive and committed to social justice, critical thinking, reflective practice, inquiry, and professional learning communities
- Evidence of strong leadership and excellent interpersonal skills

Preferred:

- Ability to contribute to innovative program development
- Ability to teach methods and/or foundational courses in areas across the TED including but not limited to: Adolescent Development and Special Needs; Educational Psychology, Information Technology, Classroom Research, School Governance.
