Archive Fever Fridays #5 Part 2 – Clara Thomas Archives (York University)

Archive Fever Fridays, an ongoing tour of the GTA's archival wonderland, seeks to expand research horizons and encourage work with local film and media materials by forging ties among students, scholars, artists, and archivists in the Toronto community.

The **Clara Thomas Archives and Special Collections (CTASC)** at York University Libraries preserves and provides access to eight kilometers of textual records and contains over 15,000 analog audiovisual items. CTASC's holdings reflect York University's long history of fostering expertise in documentary film and media arts. Archival record groups include that of James Beveridge, Donna Davey, Dini Petty, Gail Singer; and the Desh Pardesh, Regent Park Film, Planet in Focus festivals.

Archivist Katrina Cohen-Palacios will present an overview of the CTASC and its major collection areas.
