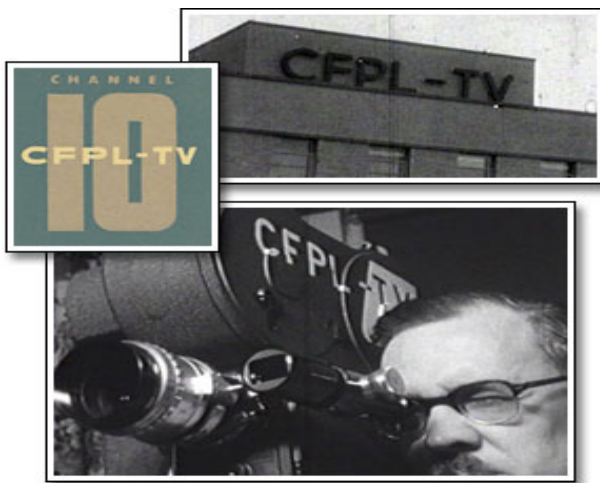

#5 Part 1 – Archives of Ontario (York University)



Archive Fever Fridays, an ongoing tour of the GTA's archival wonderland, seeks to expand research horizons and encourage work with local film and media materials by forging ties among students, scholars, artists, and archivists in the Toronto community.

The **Archives of Ontario** is the largest provincial archives in Canada, and the premier source of information about the history of Ontario and its people. Since 1903 they have been in existence collecting, preserving, and making available the documentary heritage of the province. The archives contain over 35,000 hours of audiovisual records with notable collections including London, Ontario's television network CFPL, the Theatre Inspection Branch, and the Ontario Board of Censors.

Archivist Sean Smith will present an overview of the Archives and its major collection areas.
