Are you an outgoing graduate student in Education who enjoys meeting people from other countries? Do you enjoy providing information about our city and the local cultural context and education system?

The Faculty of Education at York University requires three (3) Education students to participate in a series of fun **field trips** and to act as Language Partners (mentors) with student teachers who are joining us from Norway for five weeks. These students are studying to be teachers in a Bachelor of Education (BEd) program, and they will be completing a short program with us at York University.

Application deadline: Monday, January 20, 2020 by 4:0 pm. Interviews for these positions will be held on the afternoon of Tuesday, January 21, 2020 (in person or by Zoom)

Rationale for the Volunteer Position:

It is always challenging when staying in a new culture that not only has different surroundings, but also a different language, weather, education system, and other factors. By getting to know you through informal social-cultural activities in the Toronto area, visiting international students from Norway are able to access the expertise of a peer who has knowledge about the university, local schools and about studying and living in Toronto, Canada. They are also able to practice their use of English in regular conversation during field trips and in their learning.

Working as a language partner allows York University's Education students to make meaningful international connections, and also helps them to develop their leadership and mentorship skills while also providing a fun opportunity to meet people.

Volunteer Job Responsibilities:

- 1. Attend and pro-actively participate with the students in all pre-scheduled social-cultural activities. All admission fees and transportation will be covered.
 - a) **Orientation and meet the students:** Sunday, February 2 from 9:00 am to 12:00 pm
 - b) **Marlies hockey game:** Saturday, February 8 from 4:00 pm onwards (until the game ends) One of the Language Partners will be the lead for this social-cultural activity.
 - c) Bus trip to Niagara Falls, Niagara wine tasting and Niagara-on-the-Lake: Saturday, February 22 – 8:30am – approximately 7:00pm
 - d) **Trip to CN Tower and Ripley's Aquarium:** Saturday, February 29 from 11:30 am to 3 pm.
 - e) Walking tour of Kensington Market, Chinatown and Queen St. W. Graffiti: Sunday, March 1 from 10:00 am to 1:00 pm

- f) Lunch at the Underground Restaurant: Friday, March 6 meet students in class at 12:15pm.
- 2. Liaise with the Course Director around program expectations.
- 3. Report any concerns to the Course Director that the visiting students may have passed along to you (e.g., unhappiness in teaching practicum) so that these can be addressed.

Language Partners will have the cost of all activities covered.
