The Faculty of Education at Ontario Tech University, seeks applications for a tenure track position in STEAM Education at the Assistant Professor rank beginning July 1, 2020.

The Faculty of Education at Ontario Tech University has four main programs:

Candidates should hold a doctoral degree, with a research focus in, or related to, STEAM education. To contribute effectively to teaching in our programs, candidates should be fluent with a broad range of educational technologies, have experience teaching in fully online and face-to-face environments, and be pedagogically innovative. We encourage applicants with experience in research and teaching in K-12, postsecondary and/or informal learning environments.

Candidates have, or should be in the process of developing, an active program of empirical research and must demonstrate strong promise to develop an original, innovative, externally-funded research program, either individually or in collaboration with other faculty members. Current areas of research in the Faculty of Education can be reviewed at <u>Researcher Profiles</u>.

The successful candidate will be expected to follow a 40% teaching, 40% research and 20% service workload each year.

This position is subject to budgetary approval and will commence July 1, 2020.

This position falls within the bargaining unit represented by the UOIT Faculty Association and will be subject to the terms and conditions of the collective agreement between the University and the UOIT Faculty Association. The <u>collective agreement</u> may be found on the Human Resources section of our website. Starting salary will be commensurate with experience and annual salary increases are administered as per the terms outlined in the tenured and tenure track collective agreement.

Review of applications will begin on Mar 1st, 2020 and will continue until a suitable candidate is found. Applicants should submit in electronic format a covering letter; a curriculum vitae including a list of publications; a statement of teaching interests/experience; an outline of their present research program; a brief future research plan; and the names of three referees through the <u>Ontario Tech website</u>.
