York University Libraries is building a digital media creation lab for the Scott Library that will include an in-house audio/video studio, several editing workstations, and a set of cameras, field recorders and other equipment that will be available for loan to the York community. To support the integration of these resources into course plans, we are seeking a **graduate student in Education who has experience with lesson planning and with multimedia production.**

Over the summer, this student will help us build sample lesson plans, including guidance on timelines and frameworks for assessment, that York instructors can use to integrate audio or video assignments into their courses. These plans will serve instructors across all York faculties and departments, many of whom are passionate about creating experiential assignments for their students but do not have access to equipment or instructional support. This is an exciting opportunity to work directly with librarians, archivists, and faculty members as we get ready to launch the Scott Media Creation Lab in September 2020.

We are offering \$30/hour for an assistant to work an average of 10 hours per week from early June through September 4, 2020.
