Disrupting the Human: Rethinking Common World Difficulties with(in) a Pandemic

Description: With much of the evidence for the origins of Covid-19 pointing to the illegal wildlife trade, I began to wonder if education offered a space to rethink human-animal interactions. In reviewing a course paper I had written prior to the pandemic, I realized a critical place to begin was disrupting human supremacy. The Covid-19 pandemic offers is the call to acknowledge the fragility and interdependence of the multi-species in the Anthropocene. In this paper I hope to unfold how the complexities brought on by the pandemic showcase the need to radically rethink human-animal interactions as a way to disrupt human supremacy in education. In thinking with common-worlds pedagogies and notions of spirituality, I attempt to reimagine education as a place for profoundly complex engagements with human and more-than-human worlds as a way to invite new ways of being in the world.
